How much money does Resette have now?

2) Bomber and Pauline were weeding their family's potato patch . They each had a tub into which they threw the weeds they pulled out. At the end of the job, they weighed the tubs. Bomber had 1.35 kilograms of weeds in his bucket. Not bad! Pauline's tub of weeds weighed 2.85 kilograms.

What was the total weight of both Bomber's and Pauline's bucket of weeds?

3) Tinn-Bedongelle discovered that the price of aluminium cans had reached a great price – better than it had been for two years! She called her friend, April , and told her the GOOD NEWS!  
Both girls had been collecting aluminium cans for some time. Now was the time they would cash in on their efforts. They got their parents to take them down to the recycling centre. The weight of April's cans was 22.645 kg. Tinn-Bedongelle's cans weighed in at 38.07 kg! BONUS! More cash money!
