Questions (show all working)

1) Sari scored 350.55 out of 400 in her final commercial pilot's license test.

How many marks did Sari lose?

2) Lebbay had 1.25 litres of water left in his water bottle.
He poured out 0.65 litres for his friend, Dellem, to drink.

How much water (in litres) did Lebbay have left?

3) Topyy-Daan had a sack full of anti-bug powder for her herb garden which she had been growing for several months.
The sack weighed 4.645 kg.

Topyy-Daan worked very hard one afternoon on her herb garden. She pulled out all the weeds she could find, and she put down 2.845 kg of anti-bug powder – and she watered the herb garden as well. By the end of the afternoon, Topyy-Daan was very pleased with her efforts.

How many kilograms of anti-bug powder did Topyy-Daan have left?

4) Dame Ginger had a ball of wool which was 26.62 metres in length.

Dame Ginger played with the ball of wool for quite some time! It unravelled a bit, and Dame Ginger rolled about with it tangled all around her body.

Dame Ginger batted it and swiped at the wool with all four paws until the length of wool snapped.

Dame Ginger meowed, flicked her tail, and wandered off to find a sunny spot to nap. When Dame Ginger's owner, Boris Balerro, returned home, he saw the two lengths of wool strewn across the lounge floor.

If one of the two lengths of wool was 10.97 metres in length, how long was the other length of wool?
