Questions (show all working)

1) Doris had \$ 4662. She spent \$ 2844.

How much money does Doris have left?

2) Dwayno was busy whipping up a yummy batch of dumplings . He needed 1450 grams of flour .

When he found the container of flour his family kept in the pantry, he found there was 3264 grams of flour.

After Dwayno had taken the flour he needed to make the dumplings, how much flour was left in the container (assuming he didn't spill any!)?

3) Granette loved pet frogs . She had two pet frogs which she enjoyed caring for. Granette and her dad decided to make a new home for her pet frogs.

Granette got a piece of wood for her dad to cut. The wood was 3588 mm in length.

Granette's dad cut off 2824 mm, which he would use to build the new home. This piece of wood would be the length of the new home. Cool!

What was the length of the piece of wood that was left over - the piece of wood which would NOT be the length of the new home for the pet frogs?

4) Morpetando enjoyed wandering along the Eratine Way, which ran along the banks of Ulbessi Waterway, luxuriating in the dappled warmth of the twin suns, Susmeel and Fifmeel.

One of the reasons Morpetando enjoyed taking regular walks alongside the river was that he could collect pinto stones , which grew on the river banks. For some reason, the pinto stones which grew where Morpetando took his leisurely strolls were of the most coveted hues and shapes.

In total, Morpetando had collected 26988 pinto stones by the time he reached his thirteenth birthday. As a special birthday treat for himself, Morpetando sold 18794 pinto stones so he could buy himself a new set of Tamboon boot spurs.

How many pinto stones did Morpetando have left after selling the pinto stones to buy the boots?
