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Subtraction Worksheet (Subtracting numbers with 4 digits or more)

Questions (show all working)

1) Maisy had \$ 4711. She spent \$ 3672.

How much money does Maisy have left?

2) Basil was busy whipping up a yummy batch of pikelets . He needed 1266 grams of flour . When he found the container of flour his family kept in the pantry, he found there was 3694 grams of flour.

After Basil had taken the flour he needed to make the pikelets, how much flour was left in the container (assuming he didn't spill any!)?

3) Porshia loved goldfish . She had two goldfish which she enjoyed caring for. Porshia and her dad decided to make a new home for her goldfish. Porshia got a piece of wood for her dad to cut. The wood was 3084 mm in length. Porshia's dad cut off 2188 mm, which he would use to build the new home. This piece of wood would be the length of the new home. Cool!

What was the length of the piece of wood that was left over - the piece of wood which would NOT be the length of the new home for the goldfish?

4) Crasneer enjoyed wandering along the Pashilleene Perambuway, which ran along the banks of Unsillary Watercourse, luxuriating in the dappled warmth of the twin suns, Sesmaal and Fufmeel.
